navigating upgrading, post-secondary and funding opportunities as well as registration processes and getting transcripts.

Upcoming Programs

- **GED online, real-time; in partnership with Norquest** – Begins Feb. 1 and runs for 12 weeks. Tuesday and Thursday evenings – 3 hours per night. Cost of \$513; funding options available. This includes the course, tutor, access to resources, all online classes and completion of the official GED exam. Students will have the option of writing the exam in Pincher Creek.
- **GED online, anytime; in partnership with Norquest** – Ongoing enrolment beginning in mid-February. Cost of \$300; funding options available. This includes 30 hours of tutoring on Zoom through your local CALP. Call for further options.
- **Math and English Preparation Program; grades 5 to 9 for adults** – Ongoing enrolment beginning in mid-February. Twice weekly classes offered via Zoom; one-on-one or small group options. Please call to register. Funding options available.
- **Learner's Licence Preparation** – 10 week program offered via Zoom. Wednesdays from 4 to 6 p.m. – March 16 to May 25. This program prepares participants to successfully write their Class 7 knowledge test. Various learning strategies are shared and practised along with a focus on reducing test anxiety.
- **Potential Best** – Offered from March 1 to 17 and March 29 to April 14. Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. via Zoom. Courses covered in this program are based on group needs, but focus on confidence building, getting unstuck, goal setting and follow through, getting organized for life and learning, self-care and stress management tools. Cost of \$50; fee is waived if a barrier to learning.

- **Employment Readiness Program** – Zoom-based training to support existing or new employees with essential workplace skills such as motivation, communication, problem solving, collaboration, boundaries, presentation skills, numeracy, digital literacy and more.
